The undersigned certificateholders (the “Undersigned”) jointly move for the entry of judgment issuing a judicial instruction to Petitioners concerning the administration and distribution of the Allocable Share of the Settlement Payments for the 26 Trusts identified in the proposed judgment attached as Exhibit “A”. As more fully set out in the proposed judgment, after giving effect to the Court’s standing ruling, the undersigned comprise all certificateholders claiming an interest in those trusts with standing to appear, and each respectfully urges the Court to enter the attached proposed judgment. As there is no triable issue of fact as to these trusts or the entry of this judgment, the undersigned request that the judgment be entered without further delay so that the Subject Allocable Shares can promptly be paid to these trusts. The undersigned have conferred
